| landform | a natural feature of a land surface |
| latitude | distance north or south from the equator <br> measured in degrees |
| legend | an explanation of the symbols on a map or chart, <br> also called a key |
| location | the exact place, limit, or position of something |
| longitude | distance measured by degrees east or west from <br> the prime meridian |
| map | a drawing or picture showing selected features of <br> an area usually drawn to a given scale |
| mountain | high rocky land with steep sides |
| ocean | large body of salt water <br> the same distance apart; latitude or longitude <br> lines |
| parallels | land surrounded by water on three sides |
| peninsula | a broad area of level or rolling treeless country |
| plains | the meridian of $0^{\circ}$ longitude from which other <br> longitudes are calculated |
| prime meridian | a part, portion, or area having no fixed boundaries |
| region | flowing water that empties into a large body of <br> water |
| river | a proportion from which one can determine the <br> actual size of something |
| scale | one of the 24 longitudinal divisions of the earth <br> from which time is measured |
